Dear Parents,

The children continue to work hard in their bubbles and enjoy outdoor learning also. It is great to have so many happy faces in school. I know the children have made a bug hotel and are designing a great den in the field. It feels more normal to have the children in school and they are making great progress.

We are continuing to work closely as a trust to analyse the 35 page document that came from the Government last week and the information from Havering and Essex County Councils. The risk assessment is complex for the management team, but overall returning to school in September should be simple for the children. Here is a short summary of information that you will need to know.

All children are expected to return to school in September and wear their complete uniform including ties. The children will be able to have school dinners. The children will complete homework as normal.

Assemblies will **not** take place in September, the children will have an assembly in their classroom, until further notice from the Government. Cleaning will take place more often.

I hope you have had a chance to read your child's reports. If you get an opportunity to write a comment on the reply slip, please fill it in and post or deliver it to school. Your feedback is important to us. I am very proud of how well the children have all done during this challenging year.

Thank you to the staff for delivering all the reports and books to your homes. If your report was posted to you, your child's books are stored safely in school for you to collect in September.

The Home Learning box is in school and please return your Home Learning to school any day next week. We look forward to seeing your child's work, and it will be marked after the 72 hour quarantine. Could all Year 6 children return the revision guides to school as soon as possible please.
