You will all have the chance to meet your child's teacher at the 'Meet the Teacher' meeting on the date opposite, which will be held in the classrooms. This is a great opportunity to ask questions about any part of the school day. If however you do need further support, especially with Child Protection please make an appointment to see either of us (Mrs O'Regan or Mrs Tate) by phoning the office for an appointment.

Remember to have a **healthy snack** at break time. KS1 children get fruit for free supplied by the school. KS2 children need to bring in their own snack; this could be fruit, vegetables, a small sandwich, meat, cheese or plain crackers. Please avoid crisps, chocolate and sweets. Thank you for your support.

PE days this year will be on a Monday for KS2 and a Friday for EYFS and KS1. Please **send your child into school in their PE kit** on the correct day. We will not be storing PE kits in school unless they are needed for an afterschool club that evening.
