We are continuing to collect for the Food Bank; please drop any donations off at the gate or the main office, thank you.

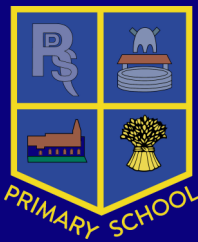
