Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back! What a fantastic first week of the Summer Term we have had. We loved hearing about all the adventures the children had during their Easter break. The children have returned to school rested and ready to learn. Yesterday we all took part in our litter picking marathon; collectively we were able to pick up over 5 full bags of rubbish from our school playground and field; WOW! On Monday 28th April, the Summer Term after-school clubs will start. As we mentioned prior to the Easter break, due to us now 'going green' and trying to be as paperless as possible, letters will not be sent confirming your child's place in a club. Instead, acceptance will be shown via the club appearing on your payment list on ParentPay. Please check your lists very carefully to ensure that you, and your children, are well prepared for their new clubs. A reminder that children must wear PE kit for all sporting based clubs (Zumba, basketball etc); any children who are not appropriately dressed will not be able to join in due to health and safety precautions; this includes ensuring that earrings are removed and long hair is tied back.

As we enter the Summer Term we would like to take this opportunity to remind parents of the Summer Uniform Policy. Children can wear either:

- Charcoal grey shorts, trousers, skirt, skort or pinafore with a white shirt, blue and gold striped tie, grey socks and black school shoes

Or

- Blue gingham dress or playsuit with white socks and black school shoes.

Nail varnish, of any kind, should not be worn to school and jewellery is limited to a wrist watch and one pair of small, stud earrings.

Could we also remind parents that all personal items, including uniform, hats and water bottles, should be clearly named. Should an item be misplaced, it is far easier to get it back to its owner if it has a name on it.

As part of our Vision ReVision morning on 6th May the children will require a 500ml plastic water bottle (single use, not reusable). Could we ask that any water bottles used between now and then are saved and brought into school. Thank you.

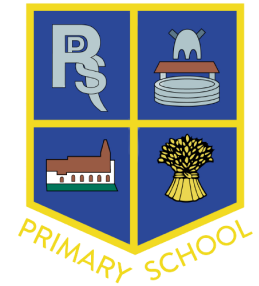
